History

Giddings E. Mabry commenced the practice of law in Tampa in 1901. Soon thereafter he founded a law firm, and was joined by his father, Milton H. Mabry, a former Lieutenant Governor of Florida who had also served as the Chief Justice of the Florida Supreme Court; Doyle E. Carlton, who would later become Florida's 26th Governor; and O.K. Reaves, a distinguished circuit judge and member of the Florida Legislature. With these men, Giddings Mabry laid the foundation of Carlton Fields. Based upon shared values of professional excellence, community citizenship and mutual support, they forged a tradition that has endured – a tradition of service to clients, community and the profession.
