The rule is set to go into effect on January 27, 2025. “Without necessarily putting a percentage, I would say I think an ultimate vacatur is more likely than I would have thought before the oral arguments,” said Weiss, but cautioned that companies should still align their consent practices given the high stakes of TCPA compliance.
