

The Dotted Line: Taking Over Construction Mid-Project

Carlton Fields construction attorney Michael Jay Rune II was quoted in a *Construction Dive* article about projects in which the general contractor or subcontractor must be replaced. Contractors must decide whether they are willing to assume the risk to step in mid-project, he said.
