The article discusses the evidence offered and rejected by the Federal Circuit in *Juno Therapeutics, Inc. v. Kite Pharma* and *Amgen v. Sanofi*, and by the District Court (by a Federal Circuit Judge presiding) in *Baxalta Inc. v. Genentech, Inc.* It also discusses the possible ramifications of potential Supreme Court intervention in *Amgen v. Sanofi* (cert petition pending) and *Juno v.
