Sklar discusses Florida’s Condominium Act, which was written to cover ancillary uses — such as restaurants, salons, and convenience stores — of mixed-use condo buildings. “Of course, the residential condo [unit owners] want and expect and should be able to control their own budgeting and destiny and decision-making within their residential parcel,” Sklar said.
