McGowan earned her J.D., with honors, from Emory University School of Law, where she was the Notes and Comments Editor of the Emory Law Journal. She earned her B.A., *summa cum laude*, from Lindsey Wilson College. McGowan has been published in the Emory Law Journal and in the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers' journal, *The Champion*.
