A mediator is also responsible for maintaining an appropriate demeanor, preserving confidentiality, and promoting the awareness by the parties of the interests of non-participating persons. A mediator's business practices should reflect fairness, integrity, and impartiality. Carlton Fields has 10 additional attorneys who are certified mediators in the state of Florida.
