He has also represented financial institutions in lender liability and commercial foreclosure actions and frequently defends corporate clients in consumer class actions, including those involving the Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA), the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), the Employee Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA), and the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA). A South Florida native, Throckmorton stays involved in the community through work with the March of Dimes and other organizations. Prior to joining Carlton Fields, he worked at the Peace Palace in The Hague, Netherlands, monitoring the International Criminal Court for the International Bar Association.
