Overview

Additionally, Troy frequently provides clients with contract advice, using his litigation expertise to identify problematic provisions and help clients account for the multitude of scenarios that may arise in connection with a contract.

Earlier in his career, Troy served as a law clerk to the Honorable Anthony E. Porcelli of the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida, handling a varied civil litigation caseload. As a federal law clerk, Troy managed an assigned docket, drafted orders and recommendations, advised the judge on legal issues, and assisted the judge in preparation for hearings, including multiday evidentiary hearings. Troy also assisted the judge in helping parties successfully resolve disputes through mediation.
