judgment and defendant David Sadek's motion for summary judgment as to Count II of the Seconded Amended Complaint (Fraud) (ECF no. 93) and as to the dischargeability of the judgments in bankruptcy is **DENIED**.

The matter is referred to the Magistrate Judge so that it can be postured for trial.
